Academic Year 2021-22 is full of significant accomplishments for GES even in the virtual mode.

Activities approved by the British Council's International Dimension in Schools were implemented in the year 2021 which has given our students critical thinking about the global issues and thus they have become globally aware and responsible. We include international prospective in teaching learning in lesson plans so that the students get exposed to different countries practices.

This session saw a switch from regular classes in the school to online classes at home. As a result, education has changed dramatically whereby teaching is being done through different digital platforms. At GES, teachers and students are regularly in contact through Whatsapp and MyclassBoard. Regular online classes are being conducted. MCB. Both students and teachers have adjusted themselves to the new ways of learning & teaching. Even physical activities, music and dance classes are conducted on line to keep the spirit live and give them some means of physical work.

Management is following all the rules and instructions given by the government in regard to covid 19 compliance.. **School management has decided not to increase the school fee for the next academic session as well keeping in mind the effect of pandemic on the parents. School was compassionate towards parental financial condition so even started monthly fee payment plan.** Many fold increase has been done in the online co-curricular and extracurricular activities for the students which include CBSE and other activities.
